*The Fairfield Heritage Association, a nonprofit organization, operates two exemplary museums in downtown Lancaster. Established in 1962, FHA purchased the Maccracken house in 1972, and accepted the Sherman House from the State of Ohio in 1982.*

### **Sherman House Museum**

137 E. Main Street

*The Sherman House Museum, birthplace of Civil War General William T. Sherman and his brother U.S.*

*Senator John Sherman, was built in 1811 and is furnished in the time period of the Sherman family. General Sherman is best remembered for his leadership during the Civil War.*



*This "little house on the hill," a National Historic Landmark, features items belonging to the Sherman family, along with a must-see Civil War exhibit.*



## **Georgian Museum**

105 E. Wheeling Street



*The Georgian is a handsome Federal mansion of 13 rooms, built in 1832 for Samuel and Sarah Maccracken. It is furnished as it might have been in the 1830's, with some original pieces and early Fairfield County items.*

*Throughout the house, 12-foot high ceilings draw eyes upward to the beautiful woodwork, archways and chandeliers. An unsupported spiral stairway leading up three floors is highlighted at the top by a lantern light.*

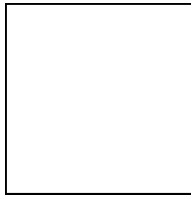
