Run With History 5K

This new fundraising event welcomes runners, walkers and history-lovers, young and old and of all abilities. They will navigate a trail through the historic Fairfield County Fairgrounds. To add to the fun, participants are urged to don historic costumes.

Columbus-based Premier Races is managing promotion, registration and logistics, so runners can be confident of a professional race experience.

Race day festivities will include:

- ◆ Trophies for first, second and third place in the men's, women's and under age-14 divisions
- ◆ Awards for the "best dressed" runners or walkers
- ◆ Finishing medals
- ◆ Drawings for gift card giveaways
- ◆ An after-party at the Fairgrounds with music and refreshments available for purchase from local food trucks.

The fee to enter is **\$35 in advance**; \$40 the day of the race. Fairfield Heritage members can receive \$5 off their advanced registration fee by contacting the FHA office *before* they sign up.

The first 200 to enter will receive tech shirts with the *Run With History* logo featuring Gen. William Tecumseh Sherman. All entrants will receive chip-timed race bibs. Results will be posted on <https://premieraces.com/results/>. There will be *no* refunds, and bibs *cannot* be transferred.

Runners can register online at premieraces.com and at the Fairfield Heritage office, 105 E. Wheeling St., Lancaster, between 9:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. The telephone number is 740-654-9923. The website is fairfieldheritage.org.

Children 12 and under can race for free by registering with the Fairfield Heritage office.

On the day of the race, registration opens at 4:30 p.m. at the fairgrounds. Packets may be picked up Thursday, April 19 and Friday, April 20, at the Fairfield Heritage office and on Saturday at the fairgrounds.
